- On 16th september '**World Ozone Day**' was organised by Aesthetic club and Ecological club under the theme "Fixing the ozone layer and reducing climate change"

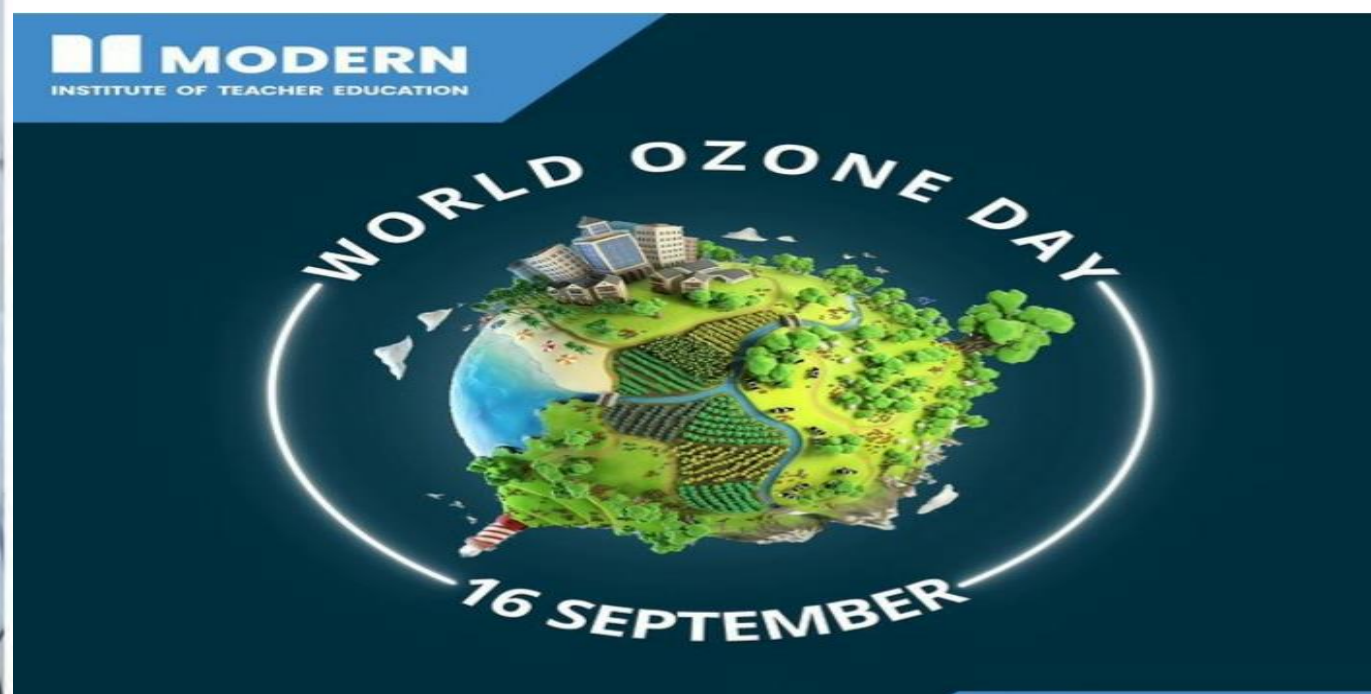
The club members participated in events such as spelling bee, debate and painting competition.
