❖ On 10th March, Literary Club organised International Women's Day.


❖ On 1st April, the Club organised morning assembly.

❖ **Competitions such as Quiz, Awareness Play & Photographgy were conducted.**


Mr. Kaina V. Zhimomi & Ms. Sevi-U Khruomo of Literary Club won the 1st position in Quiz Competition.

Ms. Medohunuo Rutsa of Literary Club won People's Choice Award in photography competition.




❖ On 31st August Literary Club jointly with Ecological Club were assigned the task of presentation for the 11th Graduation Day.


